Dear Parents,

It has been a very rainy summer!

With the excessive amount of rain we have received over the last eight weeks, we have had an influx of mosquitoes. While some children have not had any mosquito bites, some children have had many, including allergic reactions.

With this in mind, Viera Children's Academy is being proactive. We have contacted the Brevard County Mosquito Control to spray both lake areas again. In addition, we have contacted our pest control company, Slug – a – Bug, to re-spray the interior and exterior of the Academy again.

While we are taking the appropriate steps to inform you about our continued efforts to curtail the mosquito incidents, here are a few steps that you may take at home:

- Send your child to school with a fabric softener dryer sheet! The chemicals in the dryer sheets repel mosquitoes, wasps, hornets, and bees – plus your child will smell April fresh!
- AVON Skin So Soft bath oil spray – this oil is known for its effects on mosquitoes and other stinging insects

If the event of a mosquito sting, try:

- After the Bite – soothes the itching and help to treat the sting
- IVY – DRY (super) – can be purchased at health food stores and local pharmacies
- Melaleuca oil and ointment – can be purchased through local AMWAY consultants
